4. Three recommendation letters to be sent directly by the letter writers to the above

address.

5. Ph.D. dissertation (for those applying for assistant professorships) and other publications. If the dissertation and publications are in a language other than Chinese or English, an English or Chinese summary of appropriate length is required.

6. Syllabi for four courses that the applicant is prepared to teach.

Applicants whose first language is not Chinese must assume the responsibility for acquiring a working-level proficiency in Chinese.
